AL-HADI Dress Code Policy Statement:

Within the Madressa, all Teachers & Students must adhere strictly to the dress code, outlined below.

The reason why the Madressa has a dress code in place, is to re-enforce its purpose as an institute of Islamic learning, whilst at the same time for our students it will re-enforce their primary purpose and focus at the Madressa is for learning which is also the main objective to which they are being brought to Madressa by their respected parents. Furthermore, it is intended that dress code will enable an atmosphere of cohesion and unity amongst the student body.

Minimum Standards for Female Staff and Student Dress code:

"Modesty is the best Jewel of a woman" - Hazrat Bibi Faima (SA)

1. **Head Covering - Hijaab:**
 - a. Fully cover head hair, neck & ears
 - b. Non see-through fabric
 - c. Drape it to cover the chest

2. **General Wear:**
 - a. Loose fitting and non see-through clothings
 - b. Fully length skirt with long top or;
 - c. Trousers (wide legged only) with knee length top or;
 - d. Fully length Abaya or dress
 - e. to be full length upto wrist
 - f. Needs to cover down to and including ankles
 - g. No tucking in of tops

Boys Student Dress Code:

1. **General Wear:**
 - a. Shirt & trousers
 - b. no inappropriate slogans or pictures.
